### **Creative and Performing Arts extension courses: (Audition required)**

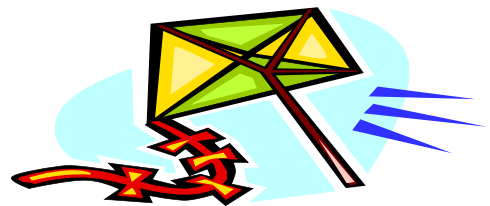

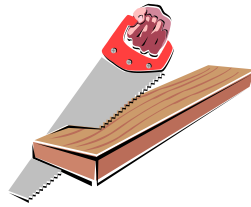
### **GAMES OF THE WORLD**



Students will learn the rules and tactics of a variety of games and recreational activities from different cultures around the world. They will develop their techniques through skills practice and games experience. Games and activities could include:

Futsal, Soft-Cross, Badminton, Bocce, Basketball, Cricket, Ultimate Frisbee, Golf, Tennis, Flag Gridiron, Netball and others depending on student interest.

## WOODCRAFT



Woodcraft is a practical course which allows the student to develop an appreciation for timber and timber products through the application of a design approach to satisfy the students' needs. You will gain knowledge, develop an awareness of your attitudes towards timber and the equipment that you will use to shape, form and sculpt designs.

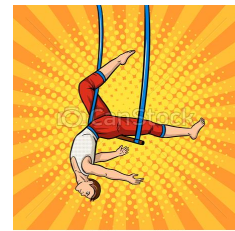
### Aim:

- To develop a creative feel or approach to utilizing wood/wood products,
- To utilize a variety of suitable timbers, techniques and equipment,
- To gain appropriate knowledge, particularly of the structure of timber.

### Content:

- Wood sculpture – cutting external shapes, e.g. money box,
- Two-dimensional shape – a sculpture in length and breadth suitable for mounting on a wall, plaque, trophy, etc.
- Small timber game projects, e.g. wood puzzles.

## AERIAL CIRCUS



Circus Arts offers students an understanding of modern and traditional circus including aerial circus, object manipulation, and individual and partner acrobatics. Circus Arts will incorporate an understanding of body awareness and circus training including elements of dance, drama, and art in individual and group performances.

## FORENSIC SCIENCE



Students undertaking this course will have the opportunity to test their deductive skills and forensic knowledge. The passion students have for forensic science can be used to increase an understanding and application of the scientific principles behind the process. Students will engage in fun and interactive simulation and practical activities to solve a case. They will develop their intellectual and scientific skills associated with some aspects of forensic science and apply them in solving a crime scenario.



## MUSIC

In the Music E-Elective courses, students study a chosen unit of work to develop instrument and singing skills with performances in either a solo and ensemble arrangement. Instruments available to learn include: guitar, bass, ukulele, piano, drums, as well as brass & woodwind for musicians who already have their own instrument. Students will also learn about aural listening skills, and composing a piece of music. It is recommended to have some basic musical skills for this course, although beginning musicians are most welcome, and are encouraged to be part of the program. Topic areas for courses include: The Pioneers of Rock, The World of Musicals, Four Chord Songs, Beatle Mania.
