Selection criteria to attend Northmead Creative and Performing Arts High School

- Proven involvement/experience and expertise in the creative and/or performing arts.
- A strong academic record
- A sound behaviour and attendance record
- An excellent attitude towards school
- Proven record of involvement in other extra-curricular activities
- Sibling rights to attend this school will **not** be granted automatically.
- Successful audition and panel interview

Selection / Audition Process

- The enclosed application form must be completed by **parents/guardians and other specified parties**. The application form must be returned to the school by **Monday 15th March 2021**.
- All items mentioned in the application form MUST be included with your application form.
- A <u>non-refundable audition processing fee of \$50.00</u> made payable to NCAPAHS is to be sent with the
 audition application form. Applications without payment will not be processed. Payments may be made over the
 phone.
- Students will be asked to audition in **one or more** of the Creative and Performing Arts areas which they nominate on the application form. If auditioning in more than one area, separate applications are required.
- Information about the audition procedure, including time and date, will be forwarded to you after the lodgement of forms.
- Supporting documentation addressing the selection criteria provided in your application will be assessed by the school in addition to the skills demonstrated in the audition process.

Information for Parents/Guardians

- NCAPAHS maintains high academic standards, encourages students to participate in a range of opportunities and has a supportive discipline and welfare structure.
- Students must wear appropriate full school uniform at all times. In addition creative and performing arts students require appropriate rehearsal wear.
- Creative and Performing Arts Ensemble students will be charged a subject fee annually, to subsidise the costs of
 equipment, photocopying, new technology and costume upkeep etc. Separate fees for the subsidy of new
 costumes required for special performances will be charged as required.
- School hours are from 8:20am to 2:32 pm for all students in the junior school. There will be additional commitments for Creative and Performing Arts outside these hours.
- NCAPAHS is within walking distance of Windsor Road buses run from Parramatta Station and has extensive bus links with Busways, Interline and other bus companies particularly into the Hills area.
- Parents/Guardians of creative and performing arts students are required to commit to particular activities to support the broad range of opportunities offered by the school.

NORTHMEAD CREATIVE AND PERFORMING ARTS HIGH SCHOOL CREATIVE AND PERFORMING ARTS AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

DRAMA

- Prepare a 3 minute monologue* performance from a play script.
 (*There is a selection of monologues on our website from which you need to choose.
 Yrs 7-10 Junior, Yrs 11 & 12 Senior)
- 2. Take part in a Drama workshop, including warm up and improvisation tasks.
- 3. Wear comfortable clothing that is easy to move in.

DANCE

- 1. Prepare a 2-3 minute solo performance in your preferred style. (**Excluding Tap**) Please bring music on a CD or iPod.
- 2. Appropriate Dance attire
- 3. No jewellery. Please tie your hair back off the face.
- 4. Students may be asked to take part in a contemporary Dance workshop. This consists of the following:
 - Teacher led warm-ups
 - Technical skills
 - Short dance sequence. Students will be required to perform the sequence in small groups

INSTRUMENTAL

- 1. Prepare a performance item of 3-5 minute duration.
- 2. Bring your instrument to the audition. (A piano, drum kit and amplifier is available for use)
- 3. Bring CD or iPod backing.
- 4. Students may be asked to participate in technical exercises, such as listening and sight reading.

VOCAL

- 1. Students should prepare a vocal item 3-5 minutes long.
- 2. Live accompaniment or backing track essential.
- 3. Students may be asked to participate in technical exercises, such as listening to and singing back vocal passages, sight reading.

NOTE: All performances should be of a standard that is above an elementary or basic level.

VISUAL ARTS

- 1. Prepare a portfolio with at least 3 original pieces and/or photographs of artwork.
- 2. Students will be asked to participate in a practical workshop.

CIRCUS

- 1. Students will participate in a workshop incliding a series of technical skills exercises and a small sequence of movements to assess their execution and performance skill.
- 2. Appropriate Circus attire; leggings, leotard or fitted shirt/acro or dancewear.
- 3. No jewellery. Please tie your hair back off the face.
